

Adam Long – PGA TOUR Professional



As a rookie in 2019 In his rookie season, earned his first career PGA TOUR title at The American Express™ and qualified for the FedExCup Playoffs, ending the season at No. 69 in the FedExCup standings. His final round 65 in the desert propelled him to a playoff win over tournament host Phil Mickelson and International Presidents Cup player Adam Hadwin. He was one of just five rookies to win las season. As a rookie he collected two top- 10s while making 11 cuts in 27 starts.

Before his time on the PGA TOUR, Adam Long attended Duke University where he is second all-time in career stroke average and started in 39 consecutive tournaments for the Blue Devils. As a child growing up in St Louis, Missouri he played baseball, basketball and ice hockey in addition to golf. After a major hockey injury, he turned his focus to golf where he lettered 4 consecutive years at Francis Howell High School, became an all-state selection and ranked as high as 8th in the Golf Week Junior Golf Rankings.
